I find it a bit boring to keep writing about fatigue. Sorry to do it again, because the fatigue is not over yet. Fortunately, there is also nicer news: my book will be launched on October 26!

My occupational therapist recently pointed out to me that my fatigue is similar to what people experience who have post-covid complaints. That was a hard pill to swallow, especially because it makes it even more unclear how long it will take to recover. I had a conversation with my GP, who referred me to a physiotherapist. That process has only just started.

Of course, I have also been reading a lot about post-covid, where it seems that, especially in the beginning, you should exert yourself as little as possible for a good recovery. I try to stick to that. I notice that with less exercise I do indeed feel (somewhat) better. It is very much against my

feelings to take it so easy. But when I do more, my body protests strongly.

In the meantime, there is still that great desire to go to Japan. This new setback seems to be the straw that breaks the camel's back after all the delays that have already occurred. I am seeking God's will in this entire process. I recently attended an intercession group, where I was prayed for, but where we also extensively prayed for Japan.


